PastaMania hits Malaysia

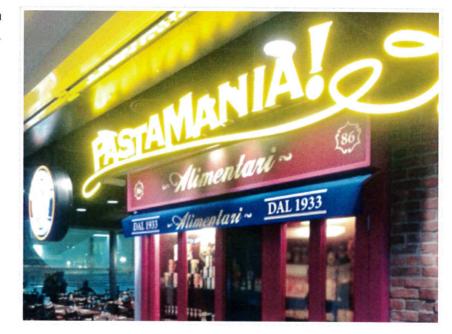
